Competition and Registration

Registration Location

On mountain check-in will be held in the National Altitude Training Center @ Silver Star Mountain.

Schedule

Friday night, February 9th

- Registration – 5pm to 7pm

Saturday, February 10

- Registration - 7:30am to 12 pm.
- Slopestyle Training – SS Mtn. Terrain Park – unofficial training
- Moguls Training – Turn Around Run – must have coach on site

Sunday, February 11

- Slopestyle Training - 9am to 2:30 – unofficial training
- Moguls Competitions – 8:30am to completion – must have coach on site
- Awards village center 1 hour after event completion

Monday, February 12

- Slopestyle Competition - 9am to completion
- Awards Silver Star village center 1 hour after event completion

Registration and Licence

- All competitors must possess a Freestyle Canada Competitor license valid in British Columbia. Athletes require a CanFree ½ or 3 license at minimum when entering this event.

- Athletes must pre-register for the event online prior to 11:59pm on February 4th, 2018. Space in the event is limited and registration is accepted on a first come first serve basis. 90 competitors per event maximum. The organizing committee reserves the right to increase if capacity permits.
- There will be a \$35 late fee for athletes who do not register online provided there is space available in the event.



Rules / Fees

- This competition is sanctioned and insured by Freestyle Canada and Freestyle BC
- This competition is being organized by Silver Star Freestyle Club & supported by Silver Star Mountain
- The competition will be held under BC Freestyle Super Youth Rules (<https://freestylebc.ski/wp-content/uploads/2015/11/SY-Guidelines-2.2.pdf>) with the following exceptions:
 - Fees - \$100 per competitor – includes two events
 - Athletes in age categories U14 to U20 are allowed to invert providing:
 - they have an Air 4 Can Freestyle coach supervision
 - and are qualified on Air Bag (or) Water Ramp
 - and on Snow by a Can Freestyle Air Qualifier
 - Athletes in age categories U8 to U12 are not allowed to invert
 - Athlete bibs must be worn during all official training and competition. No exceptions.
- Moguls Judging
 - Two Airs on a 190-200m Moguls course
 - 2 Turn Judges scoring 10 points each
 - Body Position
 - Carving – lower leg angle
 - Absorption – knees up and down
 - Fall Line
 - 1 Air Judge scoring 10 points
 - Amplitude
 - Landing
 - Execution
 - Degree of difficulty using modified score cards and group discussion
 - One Head Judge to ensure range of scores are aligned with age range
 - No timed runs
- Slopestyle Judging – See Super Youth guidelines
